Join the Diving Rebels for a beautiful weekend at Tyler State Park. The club has reserved 2 premium **lakeside sites** in Lakeview Camping Area (LV214 and LV215). If you haven't previously participated in this outing, then please consider:

TSP highlights:

- No wake lake, shallow (25ft deep), and live creatures (fish and turtles).
- Dive at your leisure - waterfront access for EASY ENTRY AND EXIT. Walk out of your tent and into the lake! Airfills available 12 miles away at Scuba Steve's in Tyler <https://www.scubasteves.com/>.
- Expansive grassy area and waterfront for relaxing, games, hammocks and launching kayaks.
- Beautiful East Texas park with 13 miles of trails, hiking and biking.
- In-park paddle boat and canoe rentals.
- The park has three fishing piers and you do not need a fishing license to fish from shore in a state park! (The park has a loaner program to loan fishing rods, reels and tackle boxes.) The lake is stocked with crappie, perch, catfish and bass.
- At Tyler State Park, you can boat, fish, swim in the lake, hike, mountain bike, picnic, geocache, camp, bird watch and study nature.

Camping:

- Each site can accommodate 2 tents. If you have a trailer/RV call me.
- Sites have electricity and water and restrooms with showers are nearby.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- April 21-23, 2023
- Tyler State Park - 789 Park Road 16 Tyler, TX 75706-9141 - Lakeview Sites 214 and 215
- Day visit only - you are strongly encouraged to obtain your day pass **in advance and online** through the Texas Parks online reservation system. You do not need to provide any site or reservation info.
- Camping- No day pass required, but you will the pay daily entry fee \$6/per day/per person. At the park check-in tell them you are with a **Group Reservation under Diving Rebels for Sites LV214 and LV215**.
- Check-in is at 2pm and check-out is at 12noon.
- Other than the mealshare Saturday night, bring your own food, drinks, and adult beverages.
- **Texas State Park regs prohibit consumption or display of an alcoholic beverage - discretion is advised.**

Participants will be asked to commit on or before the April 5 Membership Meeting.
